Awareness – Cognizant of skaters being in the pack, in the engagement zone, out of play, out of bounds, and no pack situations.										
Communication – Loudly and clearly communicated with skaters and/or officials using the appropriate verbal cues, whistles, and hand signals.										
Supplemental Tasks – Performed pre-jam duties, such as equipment checks and ensuring the proper number of skaters are on the track, and post-jam duties, such as assisting with jam calloffs and ensuring skaters sent to the penalty box at the end of the jam report properly.										
Professionalism – Officiated the game in a calm, diplomatic manner; maintained composure and focus throughout the game.										
Organization – Adequately addressed captains pre-game; had referee staff, officials, and support materials and equipment in place or available.										
Dispute Resolution – Addressed all conflicts in a thorough and timely manner, using all available resources to properly and amicably resolve issues.										
Game Flow – Kept the game going with a minimal amount of discrepancies and officials' timeouts; sorted out issues between jams.										
Overall – Accurately, consistently, and fairly performed the duties of the position.
