Supplemental Tasks – Performed pre-jam duties, such as equipment checks and ensuring the proper number of skaters are on the track, and post-jam duties, such as assisting with jam calloffs and ensuring skaters sent to the penalty box at the end of the jam report properly.												
<b>Professionalism</b> – Officiated the game in a calm, diplomatic manner; maintained composure and focus throughout the game.												
<b>Scoring</b> – Properly facilitated any pass scoring, including instances of absent skaters, skaters in the penalty box, jammer lap points, and identifying lead jammer.												
Score Reporting – Clearly communicated to the score keeper and crowd the points scored each pass, and in a timely, yet appropriate manner.												
Overall – Accurately, consistently, and fairly performed the duties of the position.
